

# "Plan for the Improvement of Graduate Student Dorm" – Preliminary Outline Description

## 1. Planning rationale and concept of the project :

Our graduate dormitories were constructed in 1991 and have been in use for over 32 years. The facilities have become outdated. In order to provide a higher quality and more comfortable living environment and align with the Ministry of Education's promotion of the "New Dormitory Movement," we are undertaking various improvements.

These improvements include upgrading the indoor bathroom facilities, renovating communal spaces, and adding simple kitchens, among other enhancements. Additionally, we are focusing on increasing outdoor and semi-outdoor spaces to extend the areas for learning and socializing beyond the indoors. Our aim is to revitalize the overall public space, creating new hubs for gatherings and activities, and further enhancing the quality of dormitory living.

## 2. Overall improvement content of the project:

Our university has invited the architect firm Yang Zilang and Chao Min Interior Design Company to assist in planning this project. The improvement plan includes:

### A. Five major plans for the external environment:

1. The landscape activity area of the central shady corridor.
2. The re-creation of the dormitory cluster's connections and public nodes, with campus image installations.
3. The design of the dormitory entrance and integration with smart device assistants.
4. The integration of the indicator system.
5. A friendly environment and disable friendly map.

### B. Six major plans for the internal environment:

1. Beautification and repair of the overall dormitory environment (design of the entrance, update of mailboxes and bulletin boards, integration of water dispensers,

integration of network equipment rooms, healthy paint for dormitory interior walls, storage and organization of electrical wires in the weak electric box, repairs to floors and painting of stair railings)
2. Sunlit corridors and multi-level common areas for socializing.
3. Public bathrooms divided into three sections (shower, toilet, and grooming area)
4. A courtyard for communication (seminar room)
5. A healthy area for diet cooking and indoor exercise.
6. Energy-saving and smart systems.
